

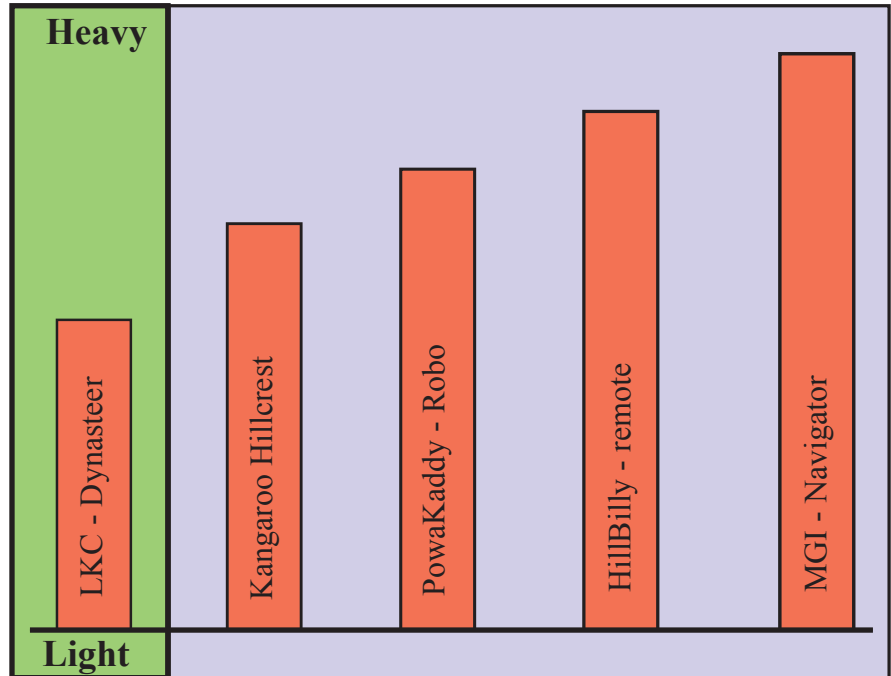

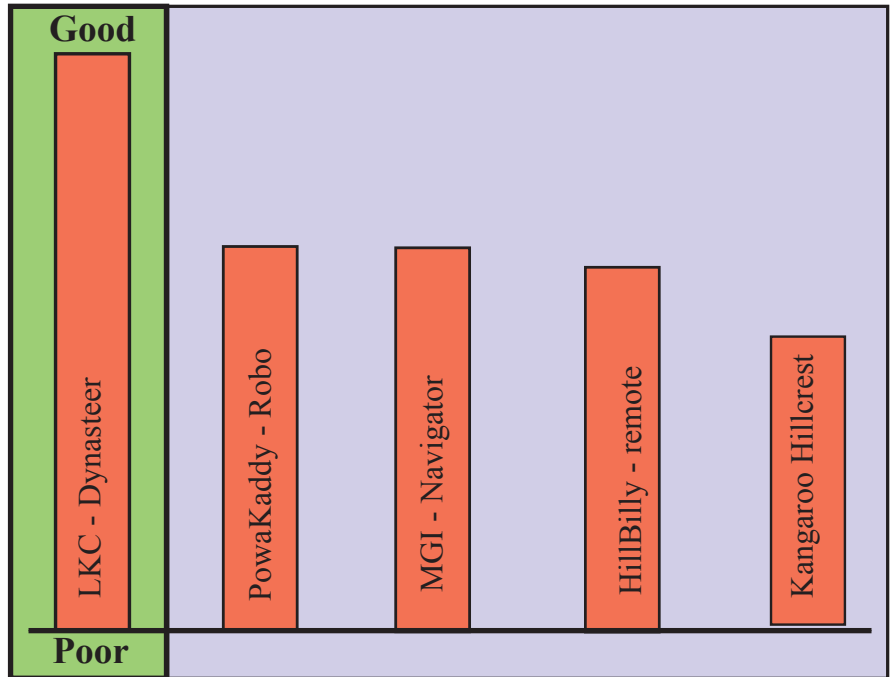
Handling Weight Comparison



Operation

The Dynasteer allows operation both manually and by remote control without switching modes as in the Robo Kaddy and Navigator. All functions are available unlike the Robo Kaddy and Hill Billy which have no brakes when in manual mode and when in remote mode cannot be controlled manually. The Dynasteer's security system and yardage selection via the control panel are unique. The Kangaroo with it's single wheel steering is much less responsive than any of the other models.

Operation Comparison



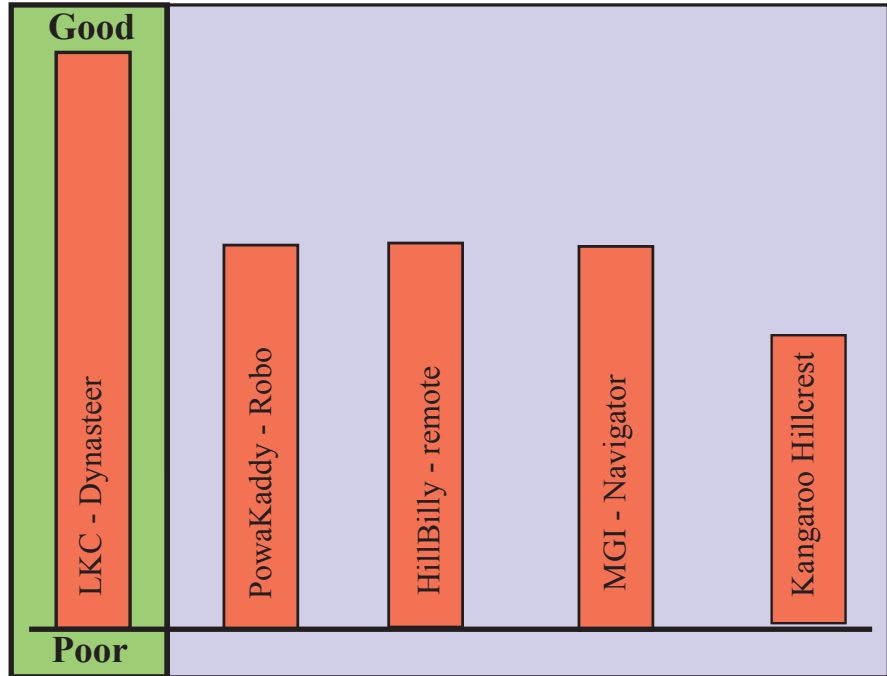

Remote operation

While all systems are Radio Frequency devices, the Dynasteer allows multi users in the same group without interference. Robo Kaddy and Hill Billy will interfere with each other. The Kangaroo unit does not have remote speed control or brakes. The large buttons on the Dynasteer hand held unit make it much easier to use than any of the others.

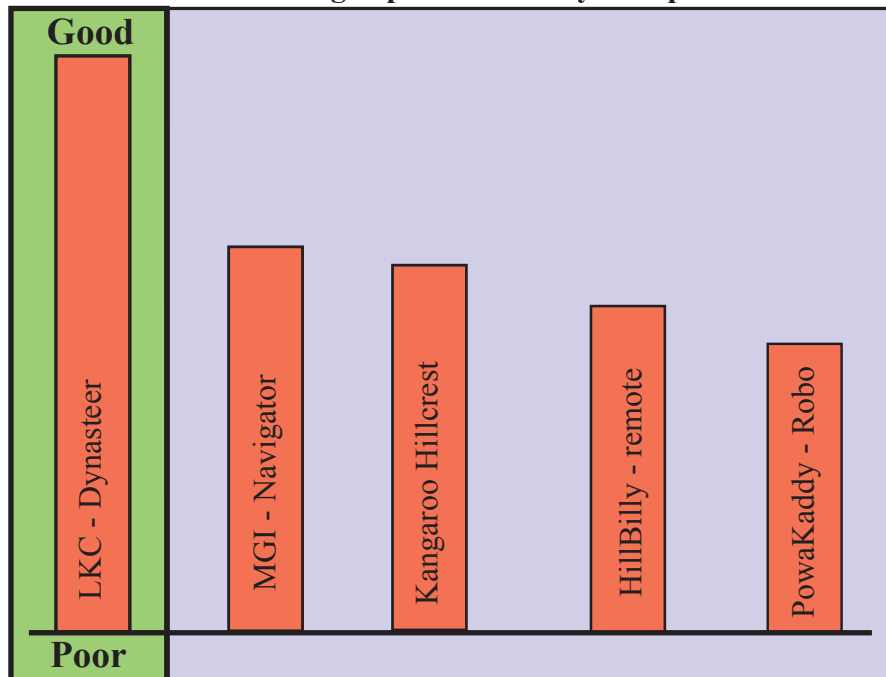
Remote Control Operation Comparison



Storage efficiency

While one piece fold down units offer some convenience, they are not efficient in space utilization when storing or transporting. When disassembled, the Dynasteer uses up to 45% less volume than the competition.
